1. **Call Meeting to Order** at 6:00 p.m. by Vice Chair Mackie.
2. **Moment of Silent Meditation and Pledge of Allegiance** was lead by Supv. Quinn, as Veteran's Committee Chair.
3. **Notice of Meeting** was read by County Clerk Olson
4. **Roll Call** was done by County Clerk Olson. Present: 18. Excused: 3 (Lee, Dohm, Sather). Youth Present: 2.
5. **Approval of Agenda** on motion by Fiedler, 2nd by Wilson; Supv. Esser requested that concerned citizens be moved up to prior to number 8; MC.
6. **Approval of December 15, 2015 County Board Proceedings** on motion by Masterjohn, 2nd by Hansen, MC.
7. **Introduction of New Finance Director** – Jane Dvorak was introduced to the board.
8. **Concerned Citizens** – Tom Frost updated the board on the status of the Trego Lake District project. Discussed schedule, grant revenues, fund raising, special charges, dredging. Mr. Frost reviewed the original request for \$25,000 as a grant and \$50,000 as an advance for up-front costs. Since the DNR has given them \$25,000 already, they will only need an additional \$25,000 as an advance and the \$25,000 grant from the county.
9. **Appointment of Highway Commissioner** – Supv. Krantz reviewed the recommendation made at the December Highway Committee and made the motion to recommend Frank Scalzo as the new Highway Commissioner, 2nd by Quinn. Supv. Esser spoke to concerns she had regarding the interview process and expressed her opposition to the vote. Supv. Wilson also expressed concerns with the process and qualifications of Mr. Scalzo. Per the county clerk, previous process was that the Highway Committee presented their recommendation to county board for appointment. Supv. Krantz reviewed the interview process with the DOT and has been done according to state statutes; this is the recommendation from committee. Questions concerning Mr. Scalzo's qualifications were reviewed. Supv. Trembath asked corp counsel if there are any concerns with this issue; per Mr. Kohler, the statutes state that the highway commissioner is appointed by the county board. Roll Vote: Yes (15), No (3) Esser, Wilson, Hansen; Youth: Yes (2); MC.
10. **Recognition of Acting Register of Deeds** – Jeff Kohler reviewed the history involved, correspondence received and discussions held with the governor's office, the government accountability board and committee of jurisdiction. Motion to recognize Renee Bell as Deputy/Acting Register of Deeds with full benefits due to an elected officer was made by Fiedler, 2nd by Bobin; MC.
11. **Consent Agenda Resolutions:** Motion to approve by Wilson, 2nd by Quinn, MC.

 - A. **Resolution 3-16 to Transfer Funds from Contingency to 2015 Corporation Counsel Budget** – Motion to approve by Fiedler, 2nd by Baier; Roll Vote: Yes (18), No (0); Youth: Yes (2); MC.
 - B. **Resolution 4-16 to Authorize the Sale of Certain Right of Way Lands Lying Along County Trunk B in the Town of Birchwood to the Indian Hills Condominium Association** – Motion to approve by Supv. D. Resolution Authorizing the Elimination of Non-Exempt Aging Nutrition Program Coordinator Position and the Creation of a New Exempt Aging Nutrition and Prevention Program Supervisor Position – Motion to approve by Haessig, 2nd by Baier. This is a budgeted FT position but the original position description is being replaced with a new one. Reviewed fiscal impact, moving the LTE to a FT exempt position, ADRC 20% reimbursement for wages (no benefit reimbursement). Benefit package has also been budgeted. Discussed creation of a new position vs modification; reviewed advertisement requirement; internal promotion considerations; need for better review of fiscal impact. Motion by Halverson to table until next month so specific data can be available, 2nd by Fiedler; voice vote resulted with the ayes being in the majority. Krantz added that committees have had issues with moving LTEs and a resolution was passed that allows committees to vote and rule on it to promote from within.

13. **Committee Reports** – motion to dispense with reports was made by Masterjohn, 2nd by Wilson; MC. Supv. Mackie mentioned that Monday, the 25th is deadline for comments on proposed UW Extension reorganization; also looking for new youth to apply by March. Supv. Mackie added that three board members attended the recent Extension meeting and he asked to know how much other counties are contributing and apparently is being chastised for asking financial questions.

14. **Chair Appointments** – Diane Poach was recognized on her recent retirement. Supv. Wilson mentioned that Stephanie Villella is our new Criminal Justice director. Supv. Haessig congratulated Stephanie on her new position and was sorry to see her leave the ADRC dept.

15. **Citizen Comments** – none at this time.

16. **Chair Comments** – none at this time.

Resolution in Support of Assembly Bill 820 “Social Worker Safety Bill”

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Act 94 Castle Doctrine declares an individual may “use force that is intended or likely to cause death or great bodily harm if the actor reasonably believes that the force was necessary to prevent imminent death or bodily harm to himself or herself or to another person” and;

WHEREAS, Act 94 exempts public safety employees such as police officers, firefighters and EMT workers and;

WHEREAS, it is recognized that social work professionals’ responsibilities involves home visits on behalf of the State of Wisconsin for purposes of protecting vulnerable children, elderly and disabled persons and that these visits include times when personal safety threats exist and;

WHEREAS, this resolution was approved by the Health & Human Services Board on February 8, 2016, on a vote of ____, with ____ voting in favor and ____ against; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Washburn Board of Supervisors supports proposed legislative changes through the Social Work Safety Act which will add certified and licensed social workers and staff aides as exempt from the Castle Doctrine, such that if social workers are killed or injured during a home visit, the resident may not use the Castle Doctrine as a legal defense.

Resolution Authorizing the elimination of Non-Exempt Aging Nutrition Program Coordinator position and the Creation of a new Exempt Aging Nutrition and Prevention Program Supervisor position

WHEREAS, our Aging management structure includes one exempt Aging Director/ADRC Supervisor who supervises the entire Aging staff including the FT and PT and LTE Cooks; and,

WHEREAS, there are benefits to moving the supervision of the full-time and part-time and LTE Cooks to the new and revised Nutrition and Prevention Program Supervisor position who has the direct daily contact with that group and who schedules this staff and works closely with the cooks on menus, supplies, coordination, purchasing, etc; and,

WHEREAS, additional duties are being added to this position as outlined in the job description draft including health Promotions programs that are already a piece of the ADRC service to our 3 county consortium; and,

WHEREAS, we have an internal LTE candidate who has been providing these same services since July 2015 based out of the ADRC of Barron, Rusk, and Washburn Counties, who would be qualified, has the necessary credentials and is promotable and could satisfy our needs in this position at 32/hours/week, and would move from an LTE position for Washburn County to a 32-hour/week position at Washburn County, with the Regional ADRC continuing to pay the 8 hour balance of the normal 40/hour work week, and with Washburn County responsible for all of the full-time benefits; and

WHEREAS, the non-exempt position salary is budgeted for 40/hr/week for 2016 for \$ 44,460 and the new 32/hr/week position salary will total \$ 37,723, for a net savings of \$ 6,737 on the salary. The benefits would have a small increase for WRS, social security, and workers comp costs due to these costs being set percentages of salary, and the proposed salary range increases with the addition of the supervisory piece. This cost is estimated to be \$ 534. Net savings estimate of \$ 6203.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Aging and Personnel Committees of Washburn County recommend the creation of this new position and selection of the current LTE Nutrition Program Coordinator to fill the current vacancy.
