CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

AREA A [Red Pine]: Harvest all orange marked trees within the designated boundaries. [49 acres]

Access, roads and landings:

- ▶ No new roads will be permitted. Reconstruction of existing forest trails will be needed.
- ▶ Landings shall be located where indicated on the prospectus map unless prior approval is obtained from the County Forest Administrator.
- ▶ Decking of wood allowed along the WCF fire lanes as long as the decked wood does not extend out onto the road surface.
- ▶ Recreation trail shall be maintained snow covered during winter months and free of debris at all times.
- ▶ Recreation trail surface will have to be restored to at least existing condition and any damaged signs/posts will have to be replaced by the contractor.
- ➤ Gates to sale area shall be closed during non-working hours.

Seasonal Restrictions:

▶ Pine cut or piled between May 1st and August 1st shall be removed within 30 days. Skidding:

▶ No pole skidding allowed April 1st through July 31st without permission.


