VOLUME, SPECIES & PRICE:

1100 Tons Red Pine (~ 490 Cds., includes ~53 MBF)

10 Tons Mixed Hardwood (~5 Cds., 50% White Birch, 25% Aspen, 25% Red Maple) 2.32 tons/cord

TOTAL MINIMUM BID: \$14,444.00

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

AREA A [Red Pine]: Harvest all orange marked trees within the designated boundaries. [49 acres]

Access, roads and landings:

- ▶ No new roads will be permitted. Reconstruction of existing forest trails will be needed.
- ▶ Landings shall be located where indicated on the prospectus map unless prior approval is obtained from the County Forest Administrator.
- ▶ Decking of wood allowed along the WCF fire lanes as long as the decked wood does not extend out onto the road surface.
- ▶ Recreation trail shall be maintained snow covered during winter months and free of debris at all times.
- ▶ Recreation trail surface will have to be restored to at least existing condition and any damaged signs/posts will have to be replaced by the contractor.
- ▶ Gates to sale area shall be closed during non-working hours.

Seasonal Restrictions:

- ▶ Pine cut or piled between May 1st and August 1st shall be removed within 30 days.

Skidding:

- ▶ No pole skidding allowed April 1st through July 31st without permission.

All additional restrictions listed on the prospectus sheet apply unless otherwise specified.

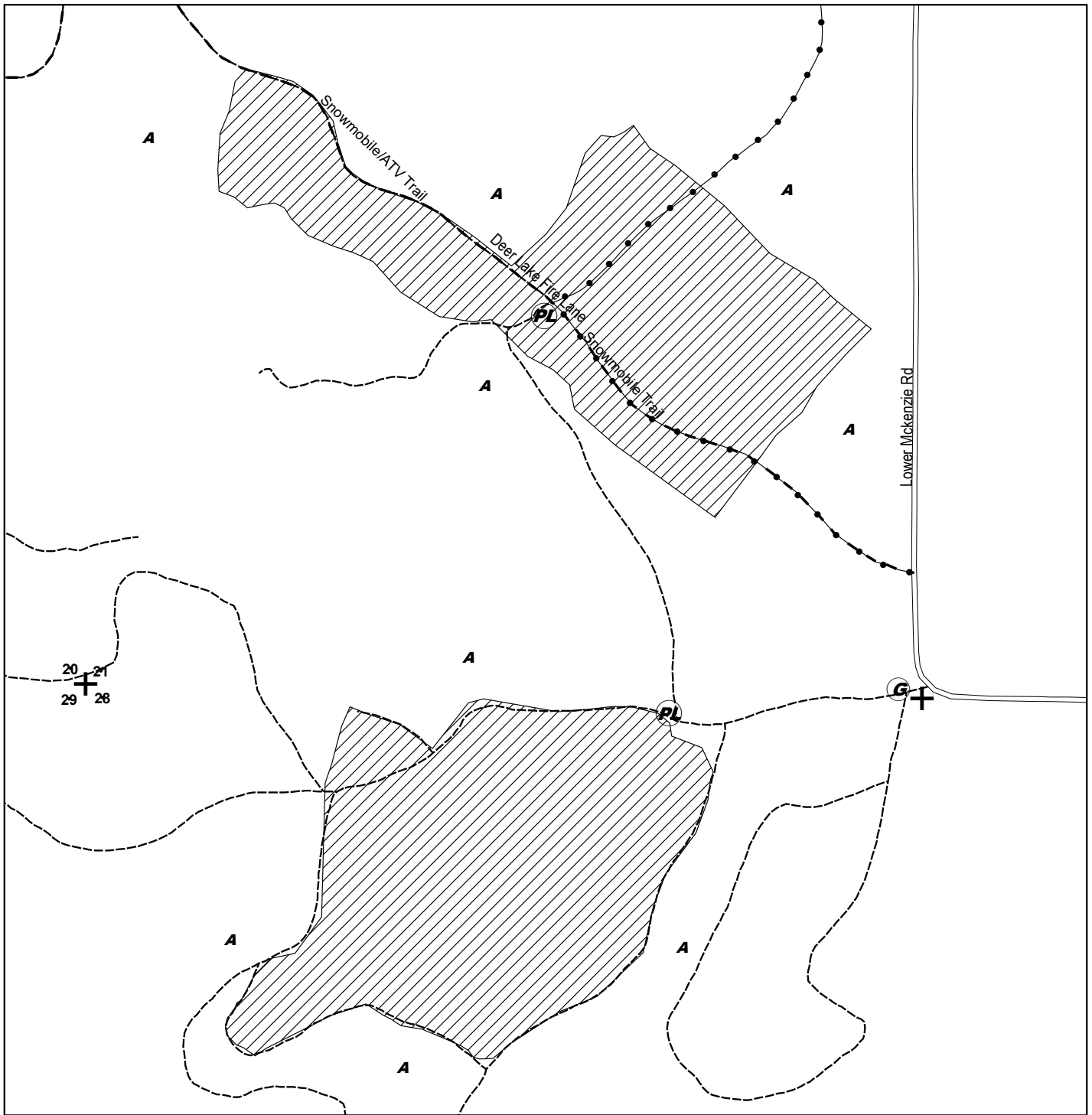
MANAGEMENT CONSIDERATIONS
