CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

AREA A [red pine]: First thinning. Harvest every third row, leaving 2 rows intact on the outside edges of the plantation. Individual rows are <u>not</u> marked. Also harvest all jack pine and aspen within the plantations boundaries. [94 acres].

Access & roads:

- ➤ No new roads will be permitted. Reconstruction of existing forest trails will be needed.
- ➤ Recreation trail surface will have to be restored to at least existing condition and any damaged signs/posts will have to be replaced by the contractor.
- ➤ Recreation trail shall be maintained snow covered during winter months and free of debris at all times. Landings:
- ➤ Decking of wood allowed along the recreation trail as long as the decked wood does not extend out onto the trail surface.
- ➤ Decking of wood along the township roads will require written permission from the township. *Skidding restrictions:*
- ➤ No pole skidding allowed April 1st through July 15th without permission.

Seasonal restrictions:

- ▶ Pine cut or piled between May 1st and August 1st shall be removed within 30 days to prevent bark beetle infestation. *Private land:*
- ➤ No slash or logging debris will be left across the blue line onto private land.

All additional restrictions listed on the prospectus sheet apply unless otherwise specified.


MANAGEMENT CONSIDERATIONS
