VOLUME, SPECIES & PRICE:

260 Tons Red Oak (~95 cds.)

300 Tons Mixed Hdwd. (~ 125 cds. 36% ash, 34% basswood, 12% hard maple, 8% red maple, 6% white birch, 2% white oak and <1% bitternut hickory and <1% elm) 2.4 ton/cd

1080 Tons Aspen (~480 cds.)

24 MBF Red Oak

10 MBF Mixed Hdwd. (57% ash, 30% basswood, 9% hard maple, 2% white oak, <1% white birch, <1% elm and <1% bitternut hickory)

TOTAL MINIMUM BID \$24,568.00

Note: 3 year contract

Area A: No harvesting activity permitted from April 1 through July 15. Oak wilt restriction.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

AREA A[oak]: Harvest all orange marked trees within the designate boundaries. [21 acres]

AREA B[aspen]: Harvest all merchantable aspen, mixed hardwood and red oak (<12" DBH) within the designated boundaries. Reserve all conifers and red oak (>12"DBH). Aspen maintenance required. [19 acres]

Access, roads & landings:

- No new roads will be permitted. Reconstruction of existing forest trails will be needed.
- Landings shall be located where indicated on the prospectus map unless prior approval is obtained from the County Forest Administrator.
- Proposed landing along town road will require written permission from the township and is the contractor's responsibility to obtain.
- A timber mat shall be utilized for trucking across saturated soil where indicated on timber sale map during non-frozen conditions. Removal of this mat shall be the responsibility of the contractor.

BMP's:

- No slash will be left in any non-forested wetlands. Do not operate wheeled or tracked equipment within 15 feet of wetlands except during frozen conditions.

Private Land:

- No slash or logging debris will be left across the blue line onto private land.

Recreation trails:

- Recreation trail surface will have to be restored to at least existing condition and any damage signs/posts will have to be replaced by the contractor.
- Recreation trail shall remain snow covered during winter months and free of debris at all times.

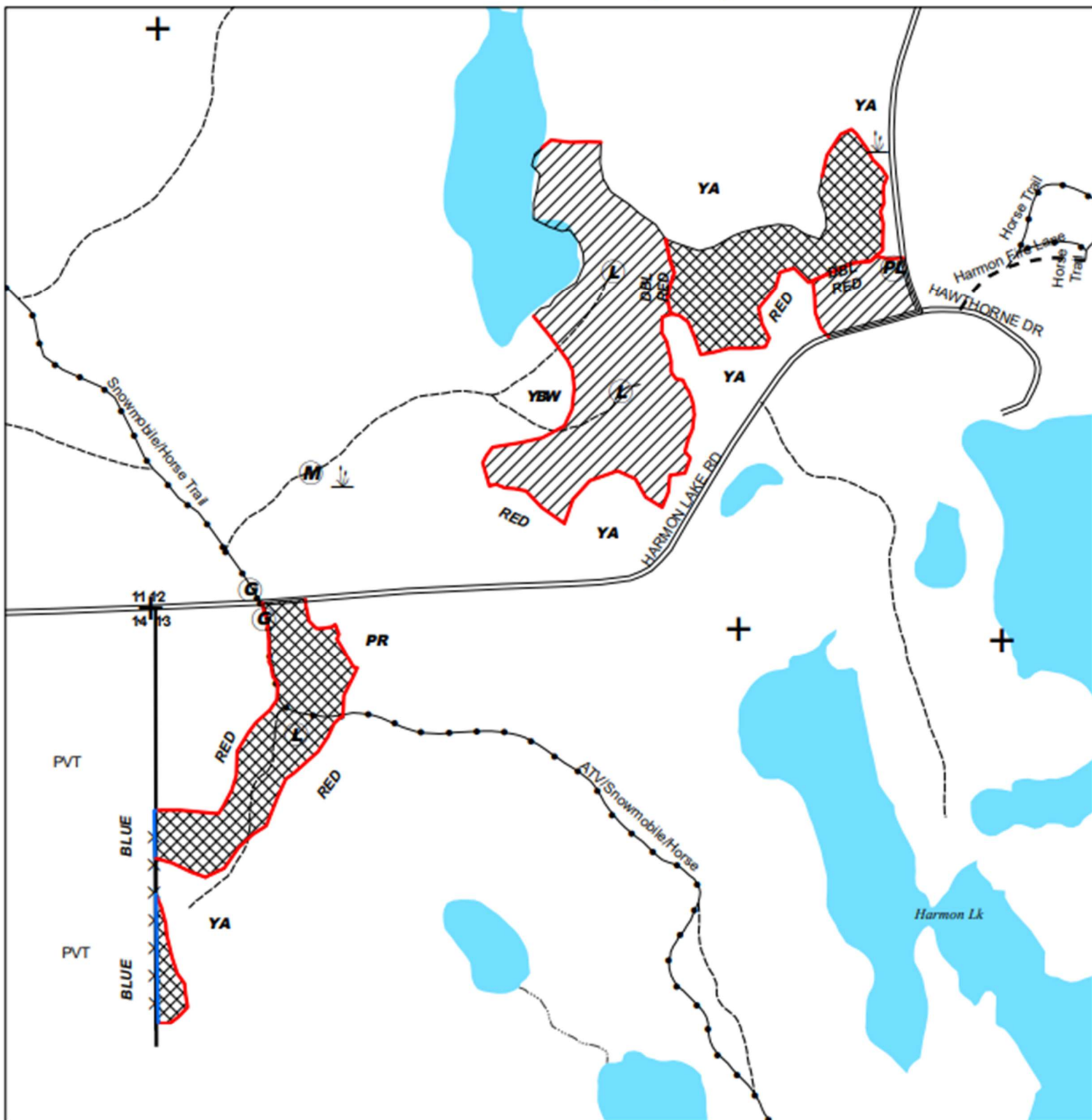
All additional restrictions listed on the prospectus sheet apply unless otherwise specified.

MANAGEMENT CONSIDERATIONS

AREA A: is a red oak saw size stand scheduled for a natural conversion to N. Hdwd with level to rolling topography on silt loam soil with a dry summer logging chance after July 15th. **AREA B:** are 54 and 51 year old aspen stands scheduled for an aspen regeneration harvest. Level to rolling topography on silt loam and loamy sand soils with a dry summer logging chance.
