CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

AREA A [Aspen]: Harvest all merchantable aspen and mixed hardwood, reserve trees include logger selected hardwood trees that will bring reserve tree density to 1-2 trees/acre. Logger selected non-aspen hardwood trees may include a variety of species, size and quality, are preferably large-crowned wildlife/mast producing trees and may be spaced out or clustered together. Aspen maintenance required. (44 acres)

AREA B [Red Oak]: Harvest all aspen and all orange marked trees within the designated boundaries. (7 acres)

Seasonal Restrictions:

- Dry summer logging chance. Harvesting operations allowed only when soils are dry enough to support equipment. Access, roads and landings:
 - No new roads will be permitted. Reconstruction of existing forest trails will be needed.
 - Landings shall be located where indicated on the prospectus map unless prior approval is obtained from the County Forest Administrator.
 - Decking of wood along the township roads will require written permission from the township.

BMPs

• No slash will be left in any non-forested wetlands, ephemeral ponds, open water or designated stream channels. Do not operate wheeled or tracked equipment within 15 feet of wetlands or 50 feet of ordinary high water mark of lake except during frozen conditions.

All additional restrictions listed on the prospectus sheet apply unless otherwise specified.

MANAGEMENT CONSIDERATIONS

Area A: is a 54 year old aspen stand scheduled for a regeneration harvest. **Area B:** is an 84 year old red oak stand scheduled for a thinning. Both cutting areas are on level to gently rolling topography with some steeper slopes on a sandy loam with dry summer chance.
