VOLUME, SPECIES & PRICE:

700 Tons Red Pine (~275 cds. 18 MBF included)
600 Tons Aspen (~265 cds.)
80 Tons Mixed Hdwd. (~30 cds. 80% oak, 10% red maple and 10 % white birch) 2.45 ton/cd
60 Tons Jack Pine (~30 cds.)

TOTAL MINIMUM BID \$17,586.00

Note: 3 Year Contract. No Biomass Harvesting Allowed.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

AREA A[red pine]: Third thinning. Harvest all orange marked red pine within the designated boundaries. No pole skidding allowed April 1st through July 31st. (22 acres)

AREA B[aspen]: Harvest all merchantable aspen, jack pine, mixed hardwood and oak within the designated boundaries. Reserve all conifers. Aspen maintenance required. (15 acres)

AREA C[red pine]: Harvest all merchantable red pine within designated boundary. Reserve all white pine. Avoid damaging white pine trees while conducting harvesting operations. (3 acres)

Access, roads & landings:

- No new roads will be permitted. Reconstruction of existing forest trails will be needed.
- Decking of wood along the township roads will require written permission from the township.
- Landings shall be located where indicated on the prospectus map unless prior approval is obtained from the County Forest Administrator.

Seasonal restrictions:

- Pine cut or piled between May 1st and August 1st shall be removed within 30 days.

BMP's:

- No slash will be left in any non-forested wetlands. Do not operate wheeled or tracked equipment within 15 feet of wetlands except during frozen conditions.
- RMZ located on west portion of sale along the Namekagon River.

Private Land:

- No slash or logging debris will be left across the blue line onto private land.

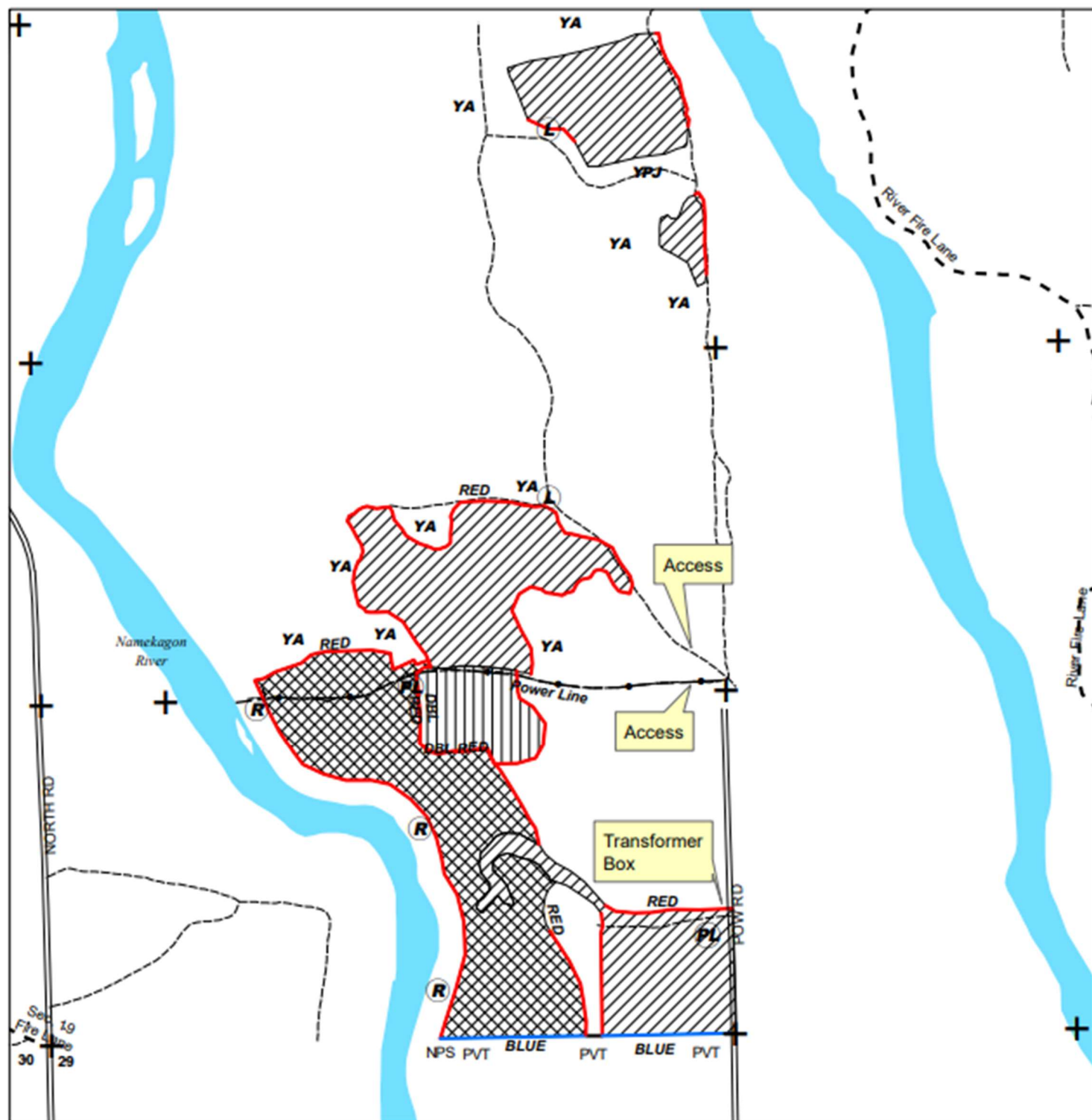
All additional restrictions listed on the prospectus sheet apply unless otherwise specified.

MANAGEMENT CONSIDERATIONS

AREA A: Is a 60 year old red pine plantation schedule for an improvement thinning. **AREA B:** Is an aspen stand scheduled for an aspen regeneration harvest. **AREA C:** Is a 75 year old red pine stand scheduled for a rotation harvest and natural conversion to white pine. Level to gently rolling topography on sandy soils with an all season logging chance.
