CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

**AREA A**[aspen]: Harvest all merchantable aspen and mixed hardwood within the designated boundaries. Reserve all red oak >12"DBH and conifers with the sale area. Do not cut contiguous pockets of black ash. Aspen maintenance required. [90 acres]

Access, roads & landings:

- No new roads will be permitted. Reconstruction of existing forest trails will be needed for hauling.
- Landings shall be located where indicated on the prospectus map unless prior approval is obtained from the County Forest Administrator.
- Use of designated wildlife openings is permitted, per prospectus regulations.

Seasonal restrictions:

- Winter logging area. Sale operations will be restricted to frozen conditions only.

BMP's:

- No slash will be left in any non-forested wetlands or designated stream channel.

**All additional restrictions listed on the prospectus sheet apply unless otherwise specified.**

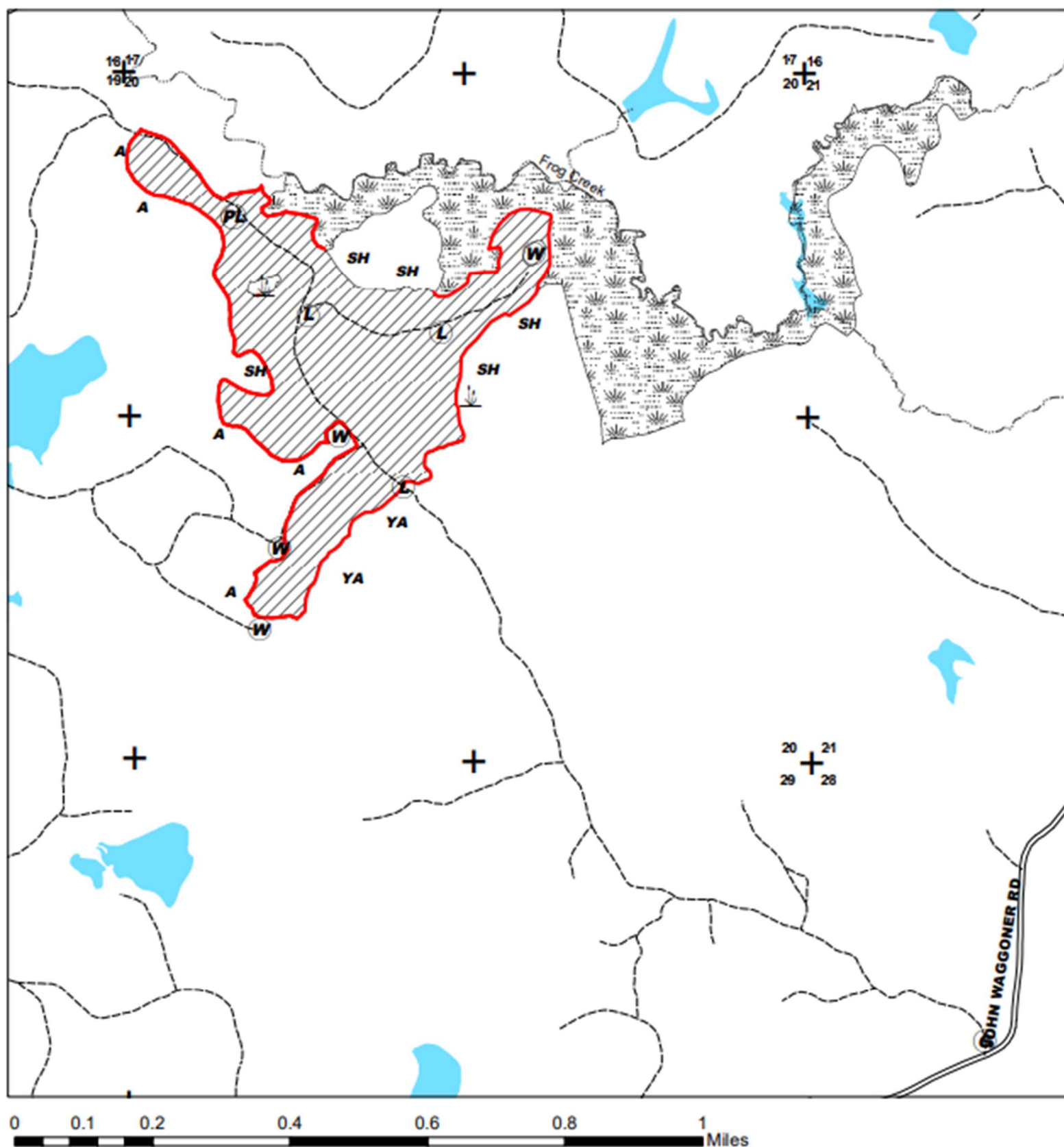
MANAGEMENT CONSIDERATIONS

**AREA A:** Is a 47 year old second rotation aspen stand. This stand is scheduled for an aspen regeneration harvest with aspen maintenance. Level to rolling topography on silt loam soils with frozen ground conditions.
