



- “There were 430,105 arrests in Wisconsin in 2006. There were 17,405 marijuana arrests that year, accounting for 4.05% of all arrests in Wisconsin for 2006. Consequently, according to this percentage basis method of estimation, marijuana arrests cost \$132.17 million in Wisconsin for 2006.”

- During the years of 2012 and 2013, Washburn County had approximately 261 misdemeanor charges of Possession of THC and Possession of Paraphernalia.
- 169 of the 261 misdemeanor offenses were for individuals between the ages of 18 and 29.




Eligible Participants

- ❖ Individuals between the ages of 17 and 30.
- ❖ First time offenders
- ❖ Individuals charged in Washburn County with Possession of Drug Paraphernalia or Possession of THC (Tetrahydrocannabinols) or Possession of Synthetic Cannabinoid
- ❖ Participants are only eligible for the program one time.


Program Description

- ❖ Participants meet with the Justice Programs Coordinator within 10 days of their initial appearance.
- ❖ An Intake Interview will be completed to verify participant eligibility for the program.
- ❖ Participants will attend four (4) educational group sessions at Aurora Community Counseling.
- ❖ Participant will pay all fees associated with the program.
- ❖ Participant will remain offense free



Incentives to Participate

- Case Dismissed
- Maintain eligibility for Financial Aid for postsecondary education
- Change unwanted behavior
