## BASIC RULES

- 1. This is an alternative to incarceration and is imposed in lieu of jail. There is an obligation to avoid any drug/or alcohol use whatsoever and volunteer to be screened for drug or alcohol use if a request is made by the Coordinator or law enforcement officials.
- 2. Enrollee will be in the home during the pre-arranged hours. Only variation includes scheduled travel time, work, treatment appointments, appointments with PO, doctors appointments etc.
- 3. Any issue related to schedule, address, and phone number changes must be communicated by the enrollee to the Washburn County Justice Programs Coordinator, Stephanie Villella, at 715.558.6569. Changes will be requested 24 hours in advance and Thursdays by noon for weekend changes.
- 4. Final determination is through the Court System

## Washburn County Monitoring Programs



Monitored through the Office of the Justice Programs



Enrollee is will be fitted with an ankle bracelet to monitor their whereabouts at all times. A schedule will be predetermined for the time the individual is on monitoring.

## **SCRAM MONITORING**

Enroll is placed on a hand held device that tracks location and alcohol consumption randomly throughout the day.

## FEES FOR MONITORING

The daily fee for electronic monitoring is \$16.88 per day.

Payments can be made by cash, check or money order and made out to Washburn County. All payments are given to the Coordinator or designated representative. A fee will be applied for any returned checks. If you are removed from the program/monitoring for any reason prior to your completion of monitoring, you will not be refunded.
