Pre-Trial Conferences for Traffic/Forfeiture

If you have been charged with a traffic or forfeiture you will have a pre-trial conference scheduled with the District Attorney's Office and be able to speak with the prosecutor assigned to your case. If you are represented by an attorney, check with them first to see if you need to attend the hearing. It is possible that your attorney will handle the pre-trial conference on your behalf. If you do not have an attorney, you understand that you represent yourself and waive your constitutional rights to a trial.
